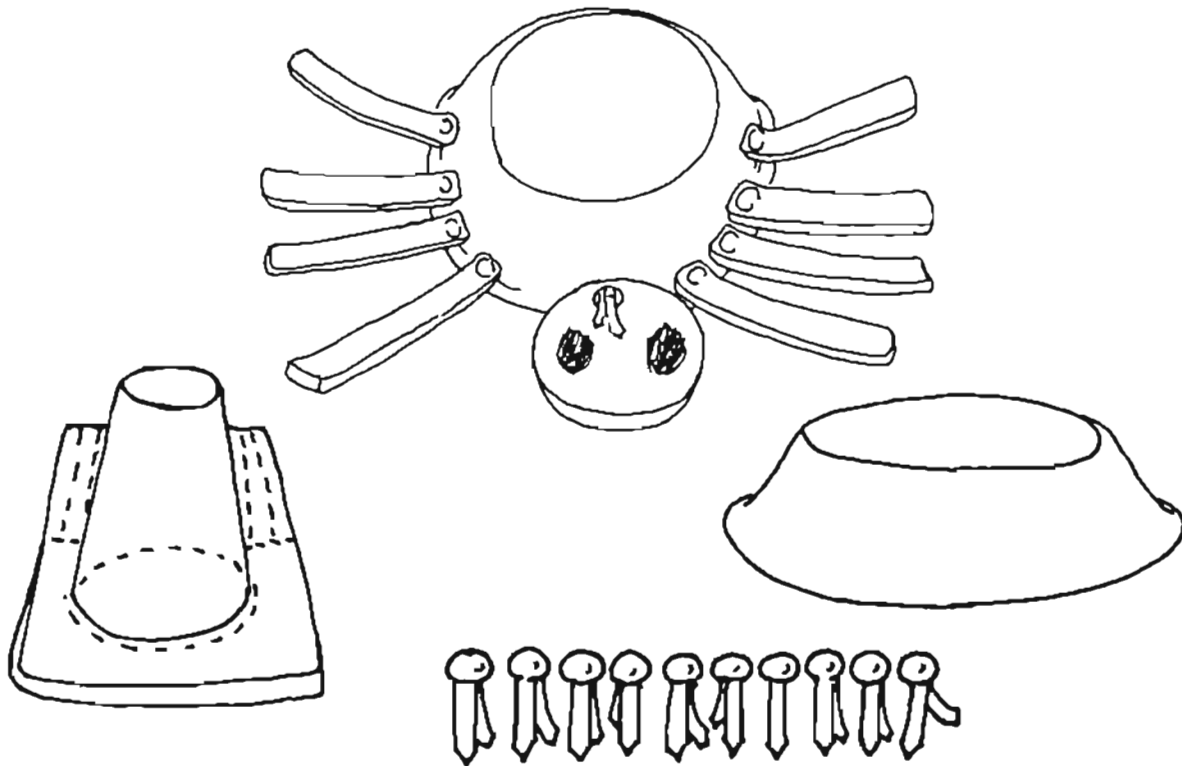


Sammy happily enjoys

Floating Sammy

What you need:

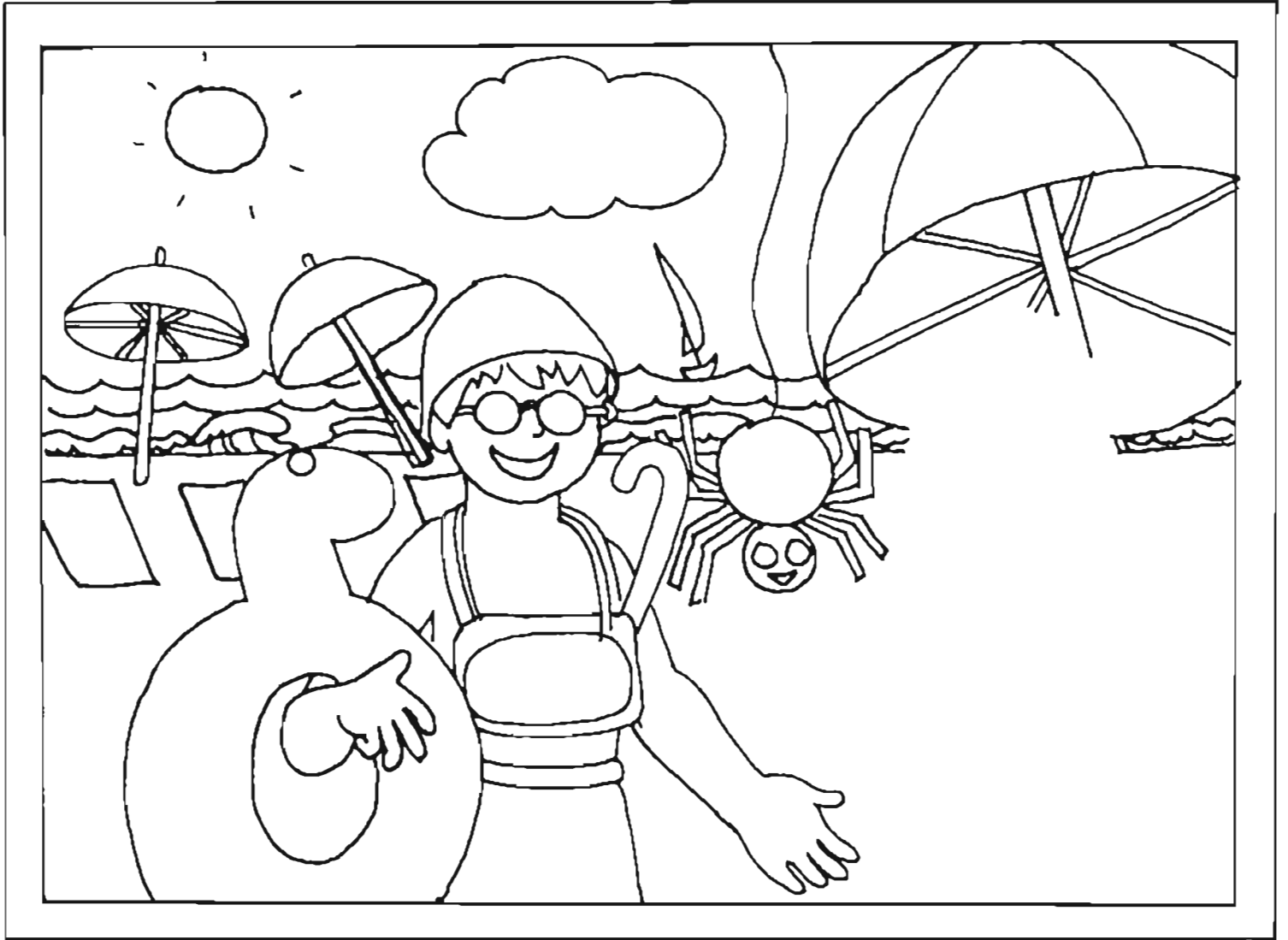
- Disposable white plastic bowl (5")
- Fun foam (available at craft stores)
- 9 metal brads
- Hole punch
- Permanent markers
- Plastic tub filled with water

What you do:

1. Place the bowl face down and color it with the permanent markers to make Sammy's body.
2. Cut a 3-inch circle out of fun foam for Sammy's head. (Use a water glass to

trace the circle.)

3. Punch holes near the edge of the bowl and on the edge of the fun foam, and connect them with a metal brad.
4. Use black permanent marker to make Sammy's eyes.
5. Cut the fun foam into 8 thin, 4-inch strips for Sammy's legs.
6. Punch holes near the top of each strip.
7. Punch four holes on each side of the bowl.
8. Attach the legs to the bowl with metal brads.
9. Fill the plastic tub with water and let Sammy swim. (He can also swim in a sink or bathtub.)
